## Kids Kamp

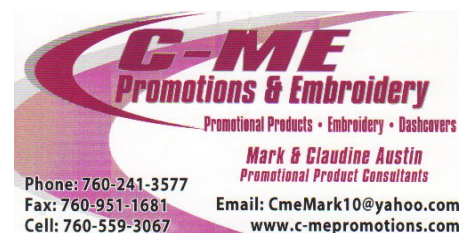

May 2011

**Opening:** The regular meeting of the Victor Valley Radio Control Flyers was called to order at 6:30 pm on May 10, 2011, in Lil' Bit Country Cafe by President Barry Young. Vice President John De Long led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Roll Call:** The roll was taken. A quorum of members was present.

### Guests and New Members:

**Meeting:** The Lil Bit Country Café changed their use policy. Future meetings will require members to order off the menu and spend a minimum of \$10.00 per person or \$50.00 per hour. Discussion followed and we will see what happens at the next meeting.

### Reports:

**Reading of Minutes:** Secretary Steve Bibler read the minutes for the April 2011 Business Meeting and the minutes were accepted as read.

**Treasurer:** Treasurer Dick Chrystie reported on the financial status of the club for April 2011. The report was accepted as read.

**Safety:** John Greenshields asked members to watch out for the fences and to be safe. .

### Events:

**Club 40 Race:** Barry Young reported on the Club 40 Race held May 7<sup>th</sup>. We barely had enough people to run the event but we got the event going. The winds kept

**Events:** Club 78 events don't close the field. There is a possibility of making the Club 40 events later in the day to allow others to fly in the morning. Without events, the club would not be active. Ron is working on events for next year and a scale event is on the table. Fred Buschbaum is asking for notice for scheduling a tailgate swap meet. He was told to check the website for our scheduled events.

**SC<sup>2</sup> Event:** Rick Pearson wished to thank Jerry Chapman, Ron Espolt, and Clint Perkins for their assistance in running the SC<sup>2</sup> event in April. There were positive comments about the field other than a wish for a grass landing area. The next coming glider event is a Man on Man event July 17<sup>th</sup>. Ten gliders will launch at once. Other discussion took place on flying thermals, flights over the runway, and future events.

**HuckFest:** Mike Stroup asked the club to bring out aircraft and fly. The event is scheduled for May 27 -29. Discussion on having a BBQ dinner followed the presentation. Members had the equipment and decided to have the dinner onsite.

**Presentation:** Rocky McArthur presented his story in model aviation and his experiences working with people in the RC hobby. His recent trip to a manufacturing facility in Taiwan was a highlight of his speech. Other topics were the future of small nitro engines and the future of gas engines.

**Raffle:** Fred Buschbaum won the \$25.00 Hobby People gift card and Charles Riether won the \$50.00 Hobby People gift card.

The meeting closed at 8:22 pm.
