Code of Ethical Conduct

Each member has a responsibility to protect the organizational and social integrity of the Victor Valley RC Flyers (VVRCF). The standards of the organization and our adherence to them, play an enormous role in determining our character as perceived by our peers and the community. The quality of an organization like VVRCF is the sum total of its membership. All of us must recognize that conduct, detrimental to the Club, may result in disciplinary action, up to and including expulsion from membership. All members are expected to meet the following standards of conduct. Each member has the obligation to contribute to the club in a positive manner. This list is not intended to be all inclusive, but instead, outline the many expectations for member conduct. As a member you are obligated to:


1. Insure your familiarity with and abide by Corporation's Code of Ethical Conduct, Flying Field Safety and Usage Rules and the VVRCF Bylaws.
2. Report any violations or unauthorized use of Club property to the Board of Directors.
3. Interact with all club members and the community in a courteous, honest, and an ethical manner.
4. Conduct yourself in a professional manner while in club meetings and at club events.
5. Notify the Secretary if there is a change in personal data.
6. Be responsible with VVRCF property or any materials to which you have been granted access or which may be in your care, control or custody.
7. Weapons of any kind, including any form of pistol, rifle, explosives, or other life threatening or debilitating devices, are not allowed at the VVRCF field. Violators of this policy will be removed from the field immediately. Violation of this policy will be grounds for a board of directors review and may result in disciplinary action or expulsion.
8. In general, do not engage in any conduct that is materially and seriously prejudicial to the interests and purposes of the corporation or violates any of its rules and procedures and/ or Rules and Regulations. Violations of these guidelines can result in disciplinary actions and/or expulsion from the club.
