- Motion from Tom Galland discussing the Special meeting held by the board was invalid due to his lack of notice by the board. Several discussions took place no member seconded on the motion of it being invalid. The special Vote of the removal of Tom Galland as president stands.
- Motion was submitted by Andrew Fischrup "If any member engages in legal action against the Club VVRCF and or board of directors, I.E. civil litigation lawsuit requiring mediation or arbitration from legal council outside the club. That member or members shall not exercise privileges of membership until said legal action has reached a settlement or summary judgements or disinvolvement is completed. Currently seeking estimates to add 300 feet to our current runway and resurface what we have.

AMA Local Membership was contacted over the event and after several attempts from different phone numbers no answer from a guy call ed Chris. Representing Hesperia planning commission. Business as usual at the field no changes shall incur over the call.
- Looking to canvas the club of the willingness to pursue static display or demo at the apple Valley Airshow. There will be more to follow on the topic once we reach out to the airfield manager. More to follow on this.
- Looking to see the support of two jet events at the club per year. One event was great boost to our club and member outreach.
- Putting together a plan for three pylon races. What it would look like how we are going to possibly set it up and possible interest.
